## Martin burial tomorrow

ACCOMPLISHED writer, photographer and publisher David Martin who died at the weekend will be buried tomorrow at Glenforest Cemetery in Harare.

The Minister of State for Policy Implementation Cde Webster Shamu last night said funeral proceedings would start at 9am today at Martin's residence.

He said the Martin family would get State assistance in the burial of the writer.

Martin is survived by his wife Phyllis, and a son Tony, who lives in Perth, Australia.

He penned over 20 books that include the Struggle for Zimbabwe, The Chimurenga War (1980), The Chitepo Assassination (1985), The Destructive Engagement: Southern Africa At War (1986 updated as Frontline Southern Africa in 1989), Apartheid Terrorism, and The Destabilisation Report.

Martin who was born in the United Kingdom, always credited his education to the decade he spent working in the media in Tanzania in the 1960s.
